

What a wonderful God we have—He is the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the source of every mercy, and the One who so wonderfully comforts and strengthens us in our hardships and trials (II Corinthians 1:3 TLB).

I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 15:13 NLT).

El Olam, Yahweh, the Creator of the ends of the earth, doesn't grow tired or become weary. His understanding is beyond reach. He gives strength to those who grow tired and increases the strength of those who are weak (Isaiah 40:28b-29 NOG).

Those who wait for the LORD [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] will gain new strength and renew their power. They will lift up their wings [and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising toward the sun]. They will run and not become weary; they will walk and not grow tired (*Isaiah 40:31 AMP*).

Cast your burden on the LORD [release it] and He will sustain and uphold you. He will never allow the righteous to be shaken (slip, fall or fail) (*Psalms 55:22 AMP*).

Jesus says: "Come to me, all of you who are tired and have heavy loads, and I will give you rest. Accept My teachings and learn from Me because I am gentle and humble in spirit, and you will find rest for your lives [for your soul]" (*Matthew 11:28-29 NCV*).

The LORD is near the brokenhearted; He saves those crushed in spirit (*Psalms 34:18 HCSB*).

The Lord heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds [curing their pains and their sorrows] (Psalm 147:3 AMPC).

Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand. I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.' (Isaiah 41:10, 13 NKJV).

My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the Rock and Strength of my heart and my portion forever (Psalm 73:26 AMP).

Jesus says: "Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge] (John 14:27 AMP).

God's shalom, passing all understanding, will keep your hearts and minds safe in union with the Messiah Yeshua (Philippians 4:7 CJB).

The LORD is good—a strength and stronghold in the day of trouble; He knows [He recognizes, cares for, and understands fully] those who take refuge and trust in Him (Nahum 1:7 AMP).

Jesus said: "The Helper [Comforter], the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. (John 14:26 NLT).

The Holy Spirit helps us with our daily problems and in our praying. For we don't even know what we should pray for nor how to pray as we should, but the Holy Spirit prays for us with such feeling that it cannot be expressed in words. And the Father who knows all hearts knows, of course, what the Spirit is saying as He pleads for us in harmony with God's own will (Romans 8:26-27 TLB).

From Groan to Glory: For I consider [from the standpoint of faith] that the sufferings of the present life are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is about to be revealed to us and in us (Romans 8:18 AMP).

Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God [and] cast all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection] (I Peter 5:6a, 7 AMP).

Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him and be strong in your faith (I Peter 5:8-9a NLT).

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight (Proverbs 3:5-6 NASB).

In His kindness God called you to share in His eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So after you have suffered a little while, He will restore, support, and strengthen you, and He will place you on a firm foundation. All power to Him forever! Amen (I Peter 5:10-11 NLT).

God will ultimately comfort, strengthen, restore and establish you, even amidst ongoing trials. He provides healing, empowerment and renewal as you stand in faith and put your trust in Him. Even though you do not understand, you rely on His goodness, character and faithfulness.

The LORD's acts of mercy indeed do not end, for His compassions do not fail; they are new every morning. Great is Your faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I wait for [and hope in] Him" (Lamentations 3:22-24 NASB).

O God, You keep track of all my sorrows. You have collected all my tears in Your bottle. You have recorded each one in Your book (Psalm 56:8 NLT).

God will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more; neither shall there be anguish (sorrow and mourning) nor grief nor pain any more, for the old conditions and the former order of things have passed away (Revelation 21:4 AMPC).

For whatever was thus written in former days was written for our instruction, that by [our steadfast and patient] endurance and the encouragement [drawn] from the Scriptures we might hold fast to and cherish hope (Romans 15:4 AMPC).

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who loved us and by His grace gave us eternal comfort and a wonderful hope, comfort you and strengthen you in every good thing you do and say (II Thessalonians 2:16-17 NLT).

I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:38-39 NKJV).

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him (John 3:16-17 ESV).

The LORD [Yahweh] is my Rock, and my Fortress, and my Deliverer; my God, my Strength, in whom I will trust; my Buckler, and the Horn of my Salvation, and my High Tower (Psalm 18:2 KJV).

Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of His saints (Psalm 116:15). Death is not an end but a homecoming for God's children, a transition into the Presence of God.

Living or dying we follow the Lord. Either way we are His (Romans 14:8 TLB).

I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write: Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth. Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest (Revelation 14:13a KJV).

[Yahweh], never forget Your promises to me Your servant for they are my only hope. They give me strength in all my troubles; how they refresh and revive me (Psalm 119:49-50 TLB).

Look! Your God! Like a Shepherd, He will care for His flock, gathering the lambs in His arms, hugging them as He carries them (Isaiah 40:9c; 11a MSG).

Praise the Lord, each one of you who fears Him [with awe-inspired reverence]. I will say. "Fear and reverence His name [and] sing His praises for He has not despised my cries of deep despair; He has not turned and walked away. When I cried to Him, He heard and came" (Psalm 22:23-24 TLB).

You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy, at Your right hand there are pleasures forevermore (Psalm 16:11 AMPC).

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord (Colossians 3:16 KJV).

Let the peace of God rule in your hearts..... and be thankful (Colossians 3:15 NKJV). Trust Yahweh always, because Yah, Yahweh alone, is an everlasting Rock (Isaiah 26:4 NOG).

You will keep those in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You because they trust in You (Isaiah 26:3 NKJV).

May the Lord of peace Himself give you His peace no matter what [has happened]. The Lord be with you all (II Thessalonians 3:16 TLB).

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:6-7 NKJV).

Jesus said: "I've told you all this so that trusting Me, you will be unshakable and assured, deeply at peace. In this godless world you will continue to experience difficulties. But take heart, I've conquered the world" (John 16:33 MSG).

The LORD will give [unyielding and impenetrable] strength to His people. The LORD will bless His people with peace (Psalm 29:11 AMP).

Abundant peace belongs to those who love Your instruction; nothing makes them stumble (Psalm 119:165 HCSB).

"Even if the mountains walk away and the hills fall to pieces, My love won't walk away from you, my covenant commitment of peace won't fall apart." The GOD who has compassion on you says so (Isaiah 50:10 MSG).

I prayed to the LORD, and He answered me. He freed me from all my fears. Those who look to Him for help will be radiant with joy (Psalm 34:4-5a NLT).

O taste and see that the Lord [our God] is good! Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the man/ woman who trusts and takes refuge in Him (Psalm 34:8 AMPC).

Look! El is my Savior. I am confident and unafraid, because Yah is my Strength and my Song. He is my Savior" (Isaiah 12:2 NOG).

And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them (Romans 8:28 NLT). "Be still and know (recognize, understand) that I am God" (Isaiah 46:10a AMP).

Weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning (Psalm 30:5b KJV). For ye shall go out with joy and be led forth with peace. The mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands (Isaiah 55:12 KJV).

Speaking of Jesus, Yeshua: It was our weaknesses He carried; it was our sorrows that weighed Him down. He was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed (Isaiah 53:4-5 NLT).

I know the plans that I have for you, declares Yahweh. They are plans for peace and not disaster, plans to give you a future filled with hope (Jeremiah 29:11 NOG).

A new day will dawn on us from above because our God is loving and merciful. He will give light to those who live in the dark and in death's shadow. He will guide us into the way of peace (Luke 1:78-79 NOG).

As for me, I will look to the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me (Micah 7:7 ESV).

O LORD, You have heard the desire of the humble and oppressed. You will strengthen their heart; You will incline Your ear to hear (Psalm 10:17 AMP).

DECREE: I will be strong and of good courage; I will not fear..... for the LORD my God, He is the One who goes with me. He will not leave me nor forsake me (Deuteronomy 31:6 NKJV *personalized*).

I wait [patiently] for the LORD. My soul [expectantly] waits, and in His Word do I hope (Psalm 130:5 AMP). You are my Hiding-place and Shield. I put my hope in Your Word (Psalm 119:114 CJB).

And now, Lord, for what do I expectantly wait? My hope [my confident expectation] is in You (Psalm 39:7 AMP).

Hope [in God's promises] never disappoints us because God's love has been abundantly poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us (Romans 5:5 AMP).

"The LORD is my portion and my inheritance," says my soul, "therefore I have hope in Him and wait expectantly for Him" (Lamentations 3:24 AMP).

Follow the example of those who always fear God for then you will have a future; what you hope for will not be cut off (Proverbs 23:17b-18 CJB). Blessed is the man who trusts in ADONAI; ADONAI will be his security (Jeremiah 17:7 CJB).

Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise Him, my Salvation and my God (Psalm 42:11 ESV).

Blessed GOD! His love is the wonder of the world (v.21). What a stack of blessing You have piled up for those who worship You, ready and waiting for all who run to You to escape an unkind world (Psalm 31:19 MSG).

Love GOD, all you saints; GOD takes care of all who stay close to Him, but He pays back in full those arrogant enough to go it alone. Be brave. Be strong. Don't give up. Expect GOD to get here soon (Psalm 31:23-24 MSG).

The LORD your God is living among you. He is a mighty Savior. He will take delight in you with gladness. With His love, He will calm all your fears. [He will renew you with His love]. He will rejoice over you with joyful songs (Zephaniah 3:17 NLT).

Let your unfailing love surround us, LORD, for our hope is in You alone (Psalm 33:22 NLT). The LORD's delight is in those who fear [revere] Him, those who put their hope in His unfailing love (Psalm 147:11 NLT).

God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control (II Timothy 1:7 AMPC).

As for me, I will wait and hope continually and will praise You yet more and more. My mouth shall tell of Your righteousness and of Your [deeds of] salvation all day long, for their number is more than I know (Psalm 71:14-15 AMP).

Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day (Psalm 25:5 NKJV). My soul, wait silently for God alone for my ^[a]expectation [^[a]hope] is from Him (Psalm 62:5 NKJV).

Behold, the Lord's eye is upon those who fear Him [who revere and worship Him with awe], who wait for Him and hope in His mercy and loving-kindness (Psalm 33:18 AMPC).

We wait for Yahweh. He is our Help and our Magen. In Him our hearts find joy. In His holy name we trust. Let Your mercy rest on us, O Yahweh, since we wait with hope for You (Psalm 33:20-22 NOG).

The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning (Lamentations 3:21-24 NKJV).

[God anointed Jesus]: "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted...and to set at liberty those who are oppressed" (Luke 4:18 NKJV).

This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses for He faced all of the same testings we do, yet He did not sin. So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most (Hebrews 4:15-16 NLT).

Let me hear Your lovingkindness in the morning for I trust in You. Teach me the way in which I should walk for I lift up my soul to You (Psalm 143:8 AMP).

Incline Your ear to me [O Yahweh]; rescue me quickly; be a rock of strength for me, a stronghold to save me. For You are my Rock and my Fortress. For the sake of Your name, You will lead me and guide me (Psalm 31:2-3 NASB).

For who is God, but the LORD? Or who is a rock, except our God, The God who encircles me with strength and makes my way [complete]. He makes my feet like hinds' feet [able to stand firmly and tread safely on paths of testing and trouble] (Psalm 18:31-33a AMP).

The Lord GOD is my Strength [my source of courage, my invincible army]; He has made my feet [steady and sure] like hinds' feet and makes me walk [forward with spiritual confidence] on my high places [of challenge and responsibility] (Habakkuk 3:19 AMP).

DECREE: I will be strong and of good courage. I will not be afraid, nor dismayed, for the LORD my God is with me wherever I go (Joshua 1:9 NKJV).

DECREE: Even though the fig trees are destroyed, and there is neither blossom left nor fruit; though the olive crops all fail, and the fields lie barren; even if the flocks die in the fields and the cattle barns are empty, yet I will rejoice in the Lord; I will be happy in the God of my salvation. The Lord God is my Strength; He will give me the speed of a deer and bring me safely over the mountains (Habakkuk 3:17-19 TLB).

DECREE: I'm sure now I'll see God's goodness in the exuberant earth. Stay with GOD! Take heart. Don't quit. I'll say it again: Stay with GOD (Psalm 27:13-14 MSG).

DECREE: Blessed be ADONAI for He heard my voice as I prayed for mercy. ADONAI is my Strength and Shield; in Him my heart trusted, and I have been helped. Therefore my heart is filled with joy, and I will sing praises to Him (Psalm 28:6-7 CJB).

Yahweh is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. Those who know Your name trust You, O Yahweh, because You have never deserted those who seek Your help (Psalm 9:9-10 NOG).

The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears and rescues them from all their troubles. The LORD is near to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. The afflictions of the righteous are many, but the LORD rescues from them all (Psalm 34:17-19 NASB).

DECREE: I love the LORD because He hears [and continues to hear] my voice and my supplications (my pleas, my cries, my specific needs) [and] because He has inclined His ear to me; therefore I will call on Him as long as I live (Psalm 116:1-2 AMP).

All who fear Yahweh, praise Him; glorify Him; stand in awe of Him. Yahweh has not despised or been disgusted with the plight of the oppressed one. Yahweh has not hidden His face from that person. Yahweh heard when that oppressed person cried out to Him for help. (Psalm 22:23-24 NOG).

Remember: God's Spirit is right alongside helping us along. If we don't know how or what to pray, it doesn't matter. He does our praying in and for us, making prayer out of our wordless sighs, our aching groans. He knows us far better than we know ourselves (Romans 8:26 MSG).

Even though I walk through the ^[a]valley of the shadow of death, [i.e. ^[a]valley of deep darkness] I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me (Psalm 23:4 NASB).

I am weary from grief; strengthen me through Your word. Keep me from the way of deceit and graciously give me Your instruction. I have chosen the way of truth; I have set Your ordinances [decrees] before me (Psalm 119:28-30 HCSB).

DECREE: Yahweh hears and has pity on me! Yahweh is my Helper! You have changed my sobbing into dancing. You have removed my sackcloth and clothed me with joy so that my soul may praise You with music and not be silent. O Yahweh my Elohim, I will give thanks to You forever (Psalm 30:10-12 NOG).

Don't panic. I'm with you. There's no need to fear for I'm your God. I'll give you strength. I'll help you. I'll hold you steady and keep a firm grip on you (Isaiah 41:10 MSG).

God is our Refuge and Strength; a ^[a]very present help in trouble ^[a]an abundantly available help] Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed [or] the mountains be carried into sea [or] its waters roar and are troubled (Psalm 46:1-3a NKJV).

The Temporal and Eternal: We are of good courage and confident hope, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord. Therefore, whether we are at home [on earth] or away from home [and with Him], it is our [constant] ambition to be pleasing to Him (II Corinthians 5:8-9 AMP).

We know that if the earthly tent [our physical body] which is our house is torn down [through death], we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens (II Corinthians 5:1 AMP).

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen ^[a]asleep [died], lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus (I Thessalonians 4:13-14 NKJV).

When this perishable puts on the imperishable, and this mortal puts on immortality, then the Scripture will be fulfilled that says, "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP in victory (vanquished forever). O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?" (I Corinthians 15:54-55 AMP).

He will swallow up death [and abolish it] for all time and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces, and He will take away the disgrace of His people from all the earth; for the LORD has spoken (Isaiah 25:8 AMP).

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to His great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for us (I Peter 1:3-4 ESV).

Now may the God of peace—who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with His blood—may He equip you with all you need for doing His will. May He produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to Him. All glory to Him forever and ever! Amen (Hebrews 13:20-21 NLT).

If it is only for this life that we have put our hope in the Messiah, we are more pitiable than anyone. But the fact is that the Messiah has been raised from the dead, the first-fruits of those who have died (I Corinthians 15:19-20 CJB).

Unless the LORD had helped me, I would soon have settled in the silence of the grave. I cried out, "I am slipping!" but Your unfailing love, O LORD, supported me. When doubts filled my mind, Your comfort gave me renewed hope and cheer (Psalm 94:17-19 NLT).

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. I have sworn [an oath] and have confirmed it, that I will keep Your righteous ordinances [hearing, receiving, loving, and obeying Your Word] (Psalm 119:105-106 AMPC).

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The blessings from our Lord Jesus Christ be upon you (Romans 16:20 TLB). God, the Source of Peace, empowers believers to overcome the influence of the evil one, and victory in Jesus will ultimately prevail.

May mercy, peace, and love fill your lives (Jude 1:2 NOG).

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify^[a] you completely [i.e. ^[a]set you apart], and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (I Thessalonians 5:23 NKJV).

I'll never forget the trouble, the utter lostness..... I remember it all—oh, how well I remember—the feeling of hitting the bottom. But there's one other thing I remember, and remembering, I keep a grip on hope: GOD's loyal love could not have run out, His merciful love could not have dried up. [Why?] They're created new every morning. How great Your faithfulness! I'm sticking with GOD (I say it over and over). He's all I've got left (Lamentations 3:21-24 MSG).

Brothers and sisters, I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us (Philippians 3:13-14 NLT).

And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue His work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns (Philippians 1:6 NLT).

It is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit, for the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God (I Corinthians 2:9-10 NKJV).

These troubles and sufferings of ours are, after all, quite small and won't last very long [in comparison to eternity]. Yet this short time of distress will result in God's richest blessing upon us forever and ever! So we do not look at what we can see right now, the troubles all around us, but we look forward to the joys in heaven which we have not yet seen. The troubles will soon be over, but the joys to come will last forever (II Corinthians 4:17-18 TLB).

I'm asking God to give you a gift from the wealth of His glory. I pray that He would give you inner strength and power through His Spirit. Then Christ will live in you through faith. I also pray that love may be the ground into which you sink your roots and on which you have your foundation. This way, with all of God's people you will be able to understand how wide, long, high, and deep His love is. You will know Christ's love, which goes far beyond any knowledge. I am praying this so that you may be completely filled with God (Ephesians 3:16-19 NOG).

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace (Numbers 6:24-26 ESV).

Now to Him who is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams], according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever. Amen (Ephesians 3:20-21 AMP).
